All Side by Side units in one class and Golf Carts**Barrels:**

There will be three barrels that you must go around as in typical rodeo fashion.

If you break the pattern or cross the start/finish line during the run, you will receive no time. It will be a 5 second penalty for a tipped over barrel.

Poles:

There will be two poles you will go down beside both poles, around the end pole, then to second pole, around it, and then back around first pole, and then back across start/finish line.

Mail Postal Delivery Race/Flag Race:

After starting, you will proceed to the first barrel, pick up the mail off the barrel, proceed around the second barrel and then put the mail in the mailbox, making sure all mail is in the mailbox and it is closed, then across the finish line. Dropping any of the mail, is cause for disqualification. There will be a 5 second penalty for tipping over the barrel, and a 15 second penalty for knocking over the mailbox. In the flag race you will pick up flag off first barrel, proceed around the second barrel and then put the flag in the bucket on the third barrel and then across the finish line.

****ATV must come to a complete stop between the start/finish line and the stop line after completing the run or you will receive a ten second penalty.

Pawnee County Fair ATV Rodeo Rules

All Participants must sign a waiver form.

All participants under age 18 must have parent/ guardian signature.

All Participants must wear a DOT Helmet.

**** Prize winners will be determined by fastest average time in ALL events. ****

RESTRICTIONS:

1. D.O.T. approved helmet and eye protection required.
2. Proper footwear, shirt (no tank tops), and full-length pants are required.
3. Speed limit is 5 mph when not participating in an individual event.
4. No alcohol or drugs of any kind are allowed.
5. Helmets must be worn at all times when riding ATV.
6. Any person who appears to be chemically impaired will not be allowed to compete.
7. Non-conformance to the principals of this event will result in immediate disqualification; subsequent expulsion and all fees will be forfeited.
8. Riding is allowed ONLY between pits and event.
9. Speed in any return lane or during non-event operation of your machine must be kept low. **NO stunt riding** (i.e. wheelies) will be allowed. Riders can and WILL be disqualified for inappropriate riding.

JUDGING:

1. The Fair Board will review all scenarios not covered by the listed rules.
2. All decisions made by the Fair Board are final.

RIDERS CONDUCT:

1. All riders shall conduct themselves in a respectful manner.
2. All riders will be in control of their machine(s) during operation. **If a participant is deemed reckless or lacking control, they will be disqualified.**

COURSE RULES:

1. We reserve the right to rework the course at any time during the event.
2. Stock and modified machines allowed.
3. Any tire size will be allowed, chains or spikes will not.
4. Helmet & goggles must be strapped on before pulling up to the line.
5. Operator must stay on machine during the run, dismounting from the machine terminates the run.
6. Any machine with a 2wd/4wd switch must stay in one position during the entire run.
7. Once forward progress stops, rider has 5 seconds to resume moving or run is over.
8. No burnouts will be allowed in the staging areas or between the staging area and the starting Linc.
9. Speeds in the return lane will be kept low. NO stunt riding (i.e. wheelies) will be allowed in the return lane. Riders can and WILL be disqualified for inappropriate riding in the return lane.
10. After completing a race, riders will immediately head to the pit area.
11. All riders wishing to compete MUST attend the Rider's meeting before the races can begin.
12. Once a rider enters the staging lanes, there will be no exiting.
13. Class jumping will be allowed as long as you are undersized for the class.
14. Staff controls the run.
15. In case of a breakdown, each rider is responsible for hooking the towrope to his/her own machine; any and all damages incurred when being pulled are the sole responsibility of the rider
